

MONDAY JULY 15TH 2019- CHILDREN'S MEDICAL CAMP, CARPENTRY, ELECTRIC REPAIRS, & BOY TALK

On this day the team arrived very early and the medical team was joined by some local medical doctors and nurses for the children's medical camp. The medical camp took place in the church and some of the team members namely Gail, Barbara, Connie, Barbara, Dona and Cathy assisted by taking the children's vital signs, counting and giving the children the medication that was prescribed by the doctors and giving them candy to cheer them up.

Onas started working on creating 30 brand new school desks for grade 8 children as the medical camp was going on while Lloyd worked on repairing all the bulbs and electric problems that were in the school, pastor Jack had a talk with the boys and led with the lunch time prayers with the children, while Pastor Mark assisted in the carpentry and electrical repairs with the rest of the team.

It was a day well spent with a lot of things being accomplished the team left the school at around 5pm having accomplished a lot of things and the children were very grateful for

the medical camp and the treatment and medications they received. The medical team was able to treat 310 children on this day!!!

TUESDAY JULY 16th 2019-COMMUNITY MEDICAL CAMP, CARPENTRY, ELECTRICAL REPAIRS

On this day everyone arrived extra early and the international medical team together with the local medical team worked very hard to treat all the community members who came in for treatment. The team barely got any breaks and at one time it was so busy that other staff members from the school came to assist in the church where the camp was taking place.

A lot of members of the community were seriously ill with some patients coming in with very high blood pressure levels of 200/90 and above and one lady was so sick that she was given an immediate referral to Kenyatta National hospital which is the biggest national hospital in the country. Follow ups were started for most of the patients and most were referred to Kayole II sub-district hospital where the local doctors from the medical camp came from. By the end of the day the medical team had seen, treated and given medications to over 550 community members!!! Many Lives were saved and transformed on this day and we can only say a big GOD BLESS YOU to Pinellas church, and First Baptist church Lenoir for making this day possible!!!

Onas and Lloyd continued working on the carpentry and electric repairs with the assistance of Pastor Mark, Pastor Jack and Ted.

The team got to leave after 5pm after a long work day having been a blessing to the community of Spring Valley.

The wonderful group also served the children during break time, lunch time and even assisted in washing the children's hands before they took their lunch. After lunch the team divided into two groups and the groups visited a total of 20 homes of our neediest children with food baskets that they had bought. The team members also took time to pray for the families they visited and the families were very blessed and moved by the gifts they received and the prayers that really encouraged them. After the home visits our wonderful visitors transformed the church into a beautiful restaurant for the staff filled with roasted goat meat, barbecue beef, barbecue chicken, vegetable salads, ugali and black forest and vanilla cake for dessert!!!!


